Summer School Learning Opportunities 2023 (Grade 9 to 12)

Summer School Learning is offered as in-person teacher-led classes from schools and independent online eLearning classes for High School students.

- **Locations:** Burlington (Dr Frank Hayden), Oakville (Garth Webb SS) and Milton (Craig Kielburger)
- **Online eLearning** offers fully online, lesson-based courses delivered through <u>Brightspace</u> at flexible times for the duration of summer school. Online teacher support is available during office hours (8:30 am to 2:15 pm).
- Full Credit eLearning and Half Credit eLearning courses meet the criteria towards earning the two mandatory eLearning courses required for graduation. Upgrade courses are excluded from this criterion.

• Registration Information:

To be eligible, participants under 18 years of age must be enrolled in the current 2022-2023 school year. Students 18 years of age and over may register as an Adult Student.

- Current HDSB students MUST register through their MyBlueprint account.
- Students from non-HDSB schools or Adult students must apply through our website https://garyallan.ca/
- VISA Students: Students currently in an HDSB school may register through <u>MyBlueprint</u>.
 VISA students who do not currently attend a high school in the Halton Region please email <u>summerschool@hdsb.ca</u> to learn more.

The Following **MUST** accompany the registration for Adult students:

- Proof of Citizenship (ex. Canadian Birth Certificate, Permanent Resident Card, Canadian Passport, Baptismal Certificate,)
- *Proof of Ontario Residency* (ex. Current utility, property tax, home phone / cable / internet bill or Property Purchase bill of sale)
- **Registration deadline:** Registration for all Secondary Credit Courses closes **June 29 at 4:00 pm.** Cancellations will be posted on www.garyallan.ca on **Friday June 30th, 2023 by 4:00 pm.**
- Maximum course load: Students may enroll in a maximum of 220 hours of coursework:
 1 full-credit course (either in-person/eLearning) plus 2 half credits / upgrades (eLearning).
- We do not confirm receipt of registration forms. New registrants will receive an email on June 30th.
 Courses will run based on sufficient enrolment and qualified teacher availability.
- Students are responsible for checking <u>www.garyallan.ca</u> to see if their course has been canceled or changed
- Students taking **in-person** courses have to arrive early to check your classroom locations on the first day.
- Students will be able to log into their online eLearning course through https://hdsb.elearningontario.ca/ on the 1st day of class using their HDSB username and password (May require signing out of all other accounts)

Grade 9 - 12 Full Credit Courses: The Secondary Summer School Credit Program provides students with the opportunity to complete additional secondary school credits during the month of July. A full list of course offerings can be found on the <u>Gary Allan Learning Centre website</u>.

- **Co-op (SHSM/OYAP/Student Success) Pre-approved HDSB students** should complete their Co-op registration on <u>myBluePrint</u>. Summer Co-op dates: July 4th August 4th
- **Designing Your Future (GWL30)** is being offered to students who self-identify as being Indigenous, Black and/or racialized. Learn more about the course here.

Grade 9 - 12 Half Credit Courses - Civics & Careers: Our half-credit courses are being offered as online eLearning courses, in an independent online environment.

Dates/Times:

- Session 1: CHV20 July 4 July 14 (including Saturday 8th July)
- Session 2: GLC20 July 17 July 28.

Grade 9 - 12 Credit Upgrades: This is an opportunity for **Grade 9-12 HDSB students** to upgrade their achievement for a full-credit course they passed (achieved a minimum of 50%) during the school year. The upgrade course is completed over 55 hours, rather than the regular 110 hours for a regular course credit. <u>Upgrade courses</u> are being offered by online eLearning, with students submitting a set series of assignments. **Students can take only 1 upgrade per session.**

Attendance and Responsibilities

A student must be diligent in their work and regular in participation. Parents/guardians will be notified about unusual absences. Regular participation is mandatory to meet credit requirements. Examinations

• For courses requiring a final exam, this will take place on the final day of classes. For online learning, the final exam will be online. More information on exams and evaluations will be given during class.

Marks to University or College

- Non-HDSB students, including Adults: If you have already applied to a college or university, please complete a 'Marks to University or College' Form.
- Marks for current Halton DSB students will be uploaded to OCAS/OUAC on August 10th with your homeschool records and as such, do not require a form unless the school requires the mark on a specific date.
- Should your university or college have a specific due date for mark submission, please include this date on your form.
